



# Guidelines 2.0 for public libraries

- Visual (e.g. infographic), digital, audio, sign language, ...  
→ accessible for library staff AND target group
- Cut short: not too much background, introduction, foreword, afterword, ...
- Immediately applicable, concrete, useful (not theoretical / abstract)
- (With hyperlinks to) Good practices
- Two-way traffic, or better: many-way traffic (colleagues, partnerships, stakeholders, target groups, ...)
