- Based on Users feedback



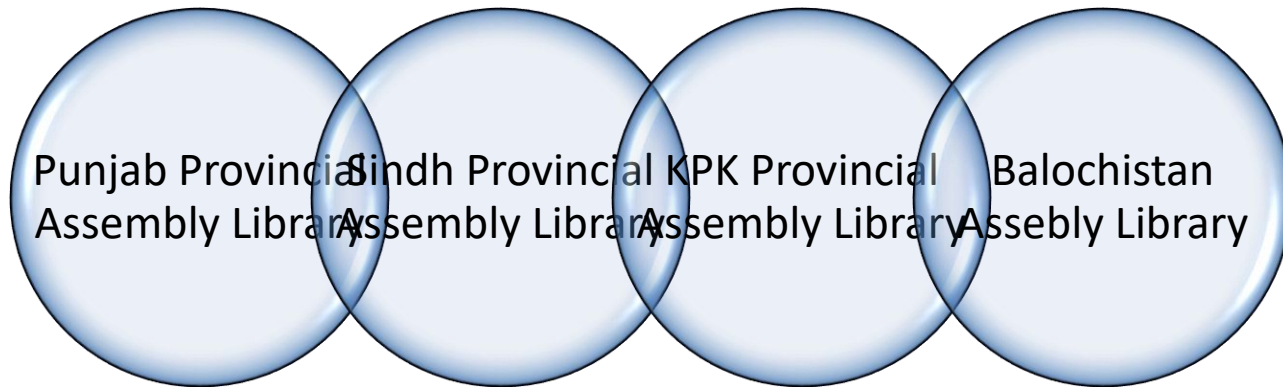
LIBRARY CONSORTIA

- Library consortium is “a group of libraries that agree to pool their resources by allowing the user of each institution some type of access to resources of all other institutions”

BACKGROUND OF MODEL

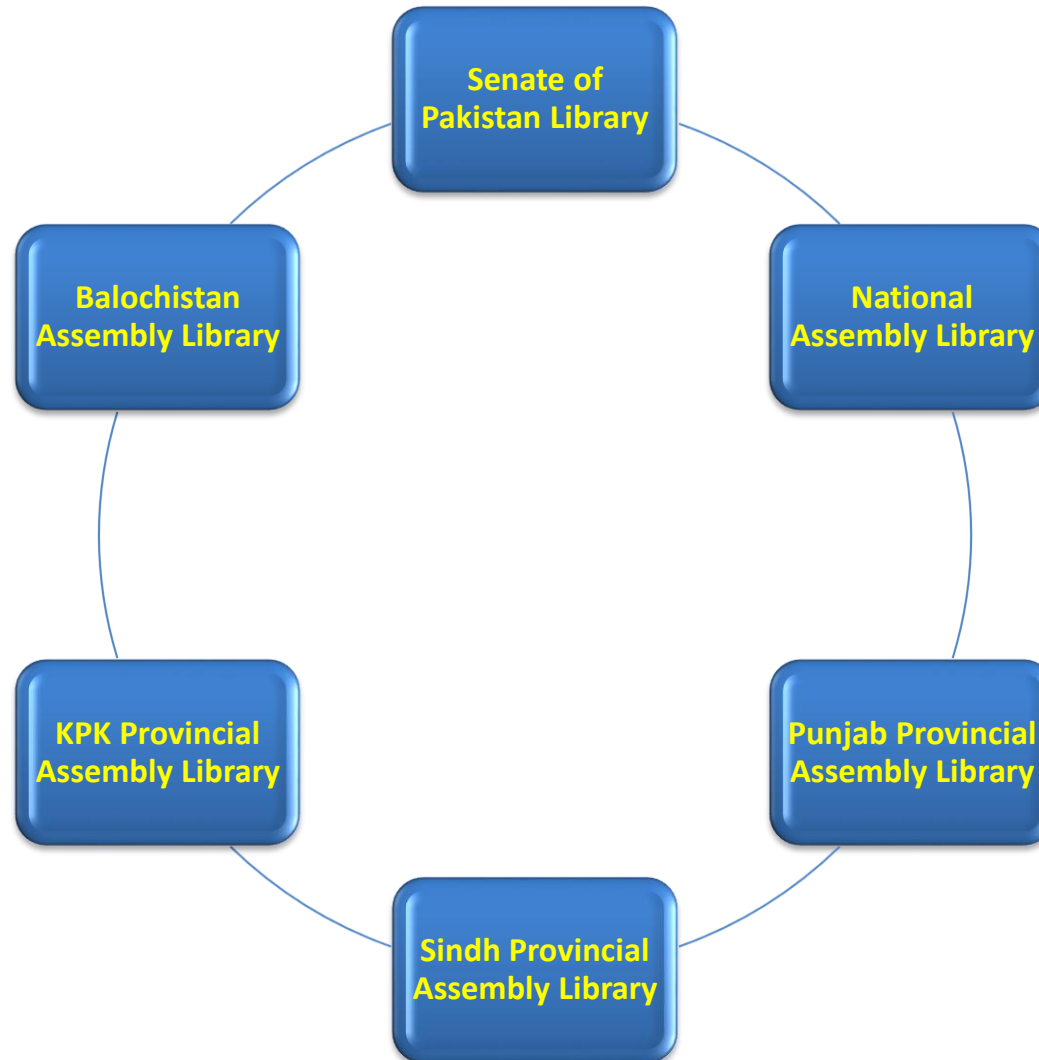
- The main objectives of this model are

NETWORKING MODEL INTER MODEL – AMONG PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLIES LIBRARIES

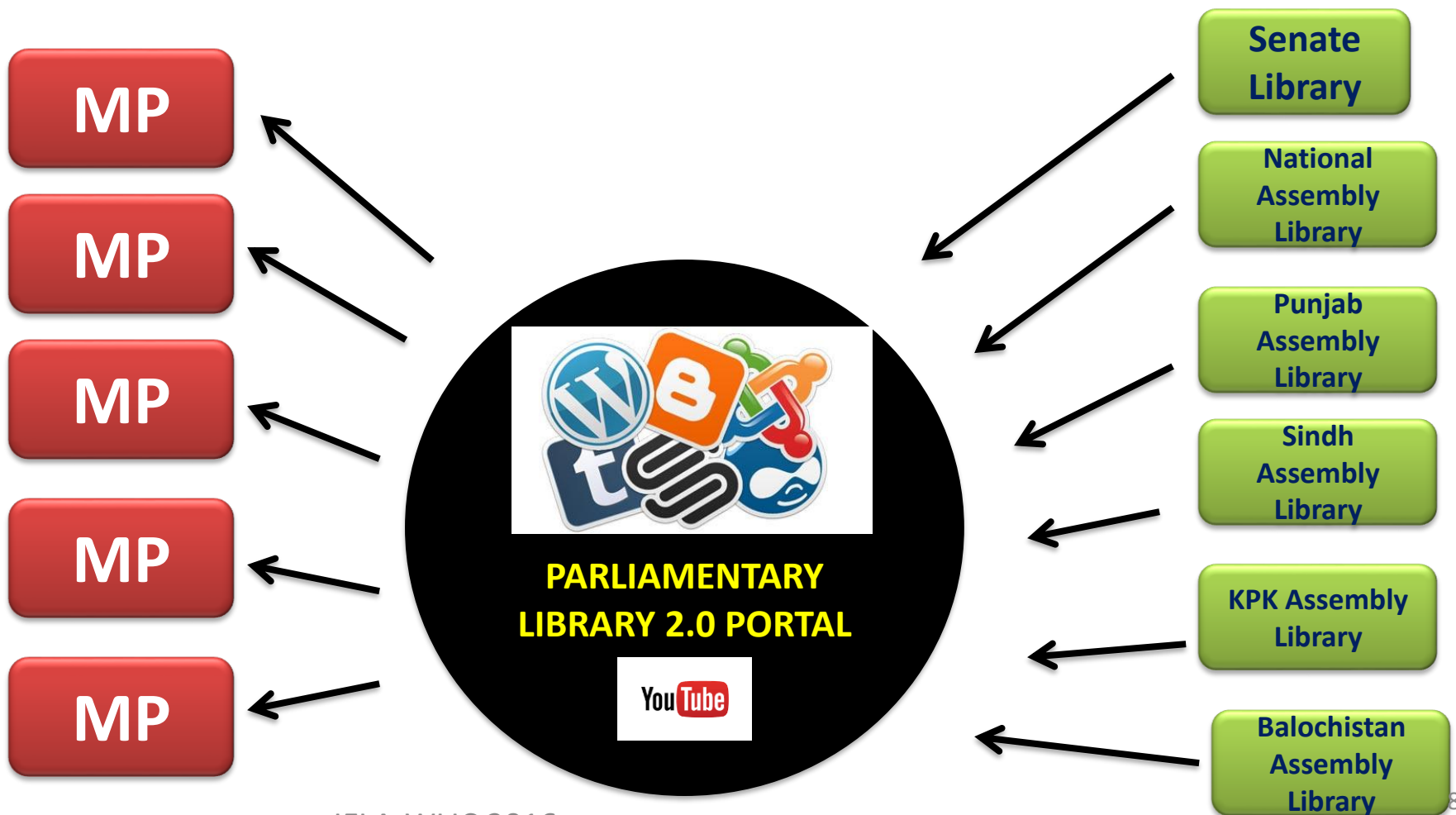


NETWORKING MODEL

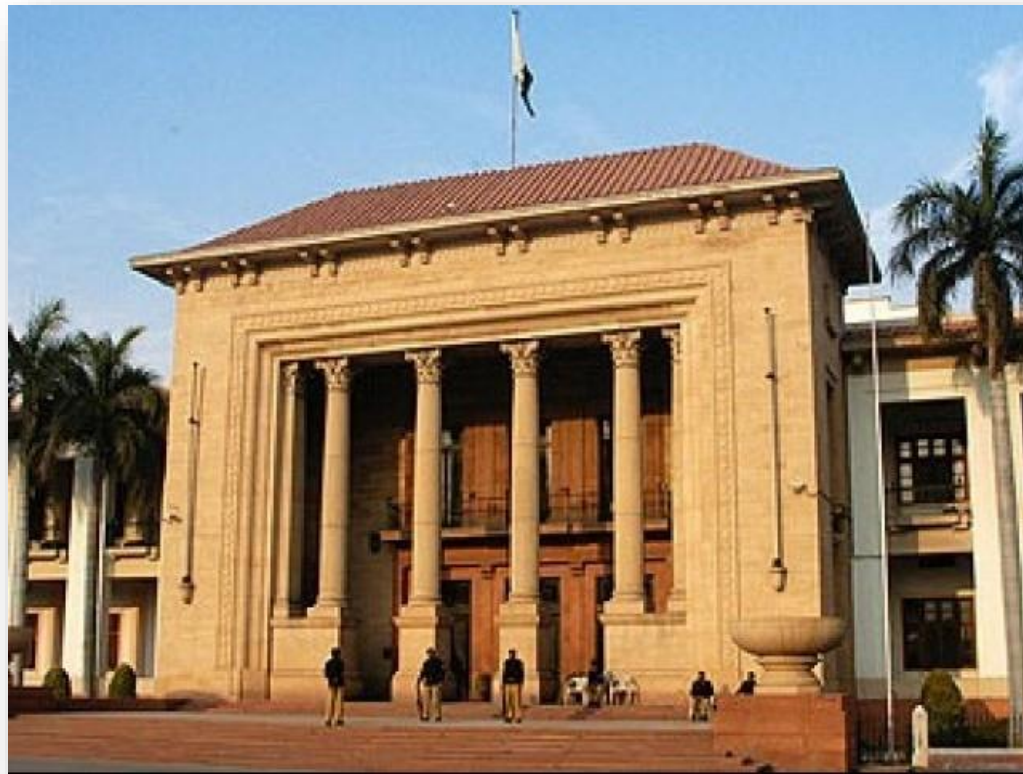
